



Before/After School Care Alternate Location

- Transportation to and from alternate locations (address other than the student's home address) for the purpose of before and after school care providers within the Town of Hudson is available under the following criteria:
 - The alternate location must be 5 days per week to be eligible for transportation. Transportation will not be available to students who attend daycare or travel to another location on a part time basis.
 - A student living in the Farley School District must go to an alternate location within the Farley School District to be eligible for transportation, a student living the Forest Avenue School District must go to an alternate location within the Forest Avenue School District and a student living the Mulready School District must go to an alternate location with the Mulready District to be eligible for transportation.
- It will be necessary to inform your student's assigned school if alternate location transportation arrangements need to be arranged for your student.
- If an alternate location (pickup/drop off) becomes necessary during the school year you should contact the Main Office at your child's school.

Riding a Different Bus for a Day

- The primary purpose of the Hudson Public Schools Transportation Department is transporting eligible students to and from home. Therefore, students are expected to ride their assigned bus each day to and from school and get on and off at their assigned bus stop.
- If you want your child to go home on a different bus, written permission must be given to the school, otherwise the child will be placed on his/her regular bus.
- Please be aware that children are NOT allowed to ride other buses except for emergency reasons.
- When requests are made to have a child take another bus because of a birthday party, parent convenience, play date or other non-emergency reason the request will be denied.
