



Parental Responsibility

- Parents are responsible for getting their children to and from the bus stops. The Hudson Public Schools in conjunction with our transportation company carefully determine bus stop locations each year. Traffic flow and volume are taken into consideration and site visits are often made when determining the placement of bus stop locations. The Hudson Police Department Safety Officer is also available and involved in the process of evaluating transportation safety issues. If you feel the reevaluation of a bus stop is necessary, please send your concerns via email to hps.busroutes@hudson.k12.ma.us or call 978-562-5186.
- Students should be visible and present at their bus stops at least 10 minutes prior to their designated pick up times.
- Kindergarten students require parent/guardian presence at the bus stop. An adult must be present at their student's bus stop as they exit the bus. If a parent/guardian or responsible adult is not present at the stop, the child will be returned to their respective school where the child must be picked up by a parent or responsible adult with proper identification.

Student Responsibility

- Student behavior on the bus should be the same as it is in the classroom. The bus ride to and from school should be considered an extension of the school day.
- If a student chooses to engage in inappropriate behavior on the bus the bus driver will follow the process outlined in the School Committee Policy for [Student Transportation: Discipline](#).
